Information Checklist

A completed application requires the following items to be submitted to our office:

- The application
- A Current Photo
- A copy of the results of your ACT and/or SAT scores. Please submit all available scores. Applicants may choose to notify the SAT/ACT testing centers to request that scores be sent directly to Senator Peters' office. Due to costs of requesting original copies guidance counselors may submit these scores with the candidate's official transcript in a sealed envelope signed on the seal.
- Official High School Transcript
- Biographical sketch - include your reason for wanting to attend an Academy, long and short term goals, and plans for the future should you not receive an appointment.
- A list of your extracurricular activities; leadership responsibilities, sports, certifications, Awards and Honors, or notable hobbies'
- Letters of recommendation. Please obtain recommendations from 3 people, including 2 from an academic source. The other recommendation may come from an academic source or a non-academic source such as coaches, employers, clergy, neighbors or other non-family members who can accurately comment on the applicant's character, abilities and potential. All letters of recommendation must be submitted with your application in a sealed envelope with the author's signature across the seal.

OVERVIEW OF THE ACADEMY PROCESS

1. **Applications are due on October 31** in the **district office**.
2. **Interview:** After the October 31 deadline you will be contacted by my office with a scheduled interview appointment with my advisory panel. All candidates are required to attend the interview.
3. Students receive a letter notifying them of whether they are receiving a nomination by late January.
4. Nominations are submitted by my office to the respective academies by the January 31 deadline. Once nominations are submitted, it is up to the respective Academies to offer an appointment.
5. Students who are offered an appointment by the Academies are notified sometime in February, March, or April.
6. May 1 is the deadline for students who have been offered to accept their appointment.
7. Appointees enter their respective Academies in July.
